1. **Amendment to Sec. 8-1403, “PLUMBING LICENSE,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances**  
(Amy Keys, Deputy City Attorney)

**Explanation:** Section 8-1403, “PLUMBING LICENSE,” of the Code currently provides that individuals applying for a plumbing permit to conduct work within the City must be a licensed plumber and must register with the City and pay a \$50 administrative filing fee. Pursuant to recent amendments to the Illinois Plumbing License Law, 225 ILCS 320/42, such licensing requirements must be regulated by the State of Illinois. Amending Sec. 8-1403 will bring the Code into compliance with the State statute regarding the licensure and registration of plumbers.

**Staff Recommendation:** Approval

**Fiscal Impact:** A refund of \$1,350 in fees paid this year, and an approximate yearly reduction of the same amount in future years
