## 5. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4014-2012

A Special Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Lease and Concession Agreement with Roy's All Fed Up, Inc., (2504 18<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Apt. D, Rock Island, IL 61201) to sell food and beverages from a mobile concession stand along a portion of Ben Butterworth Parkway (RICO Parcel 08-2644-A) from April 1, 2012 through November 30, 2012.
