Explanation

1. Approval of the Installation of a Retaining Wall at Parking Lot S 1414 6th Avenue. (Scott Hinton, City Engineer)

Explanation: There is an elevation difference between the north edge of Parking Lot S at 1414 6th Avenue and the sidewalk along the south side of 6th Avenue. This elevation difference is bridged by a slope which is covered in concrete. The concrete is in poor condition and allows storm water runoff from the parking lot to erode the soil under the concrete and undermine the asphalt surface of the parking lot. Staff proposes to permanently repair the area by installing a retaining wall and storm sewer. A preliminary cost estimate for this work is approximately \$80,000. Additional documentation attached.

Staff Recommendation: Approval

Fiscal Impact: Funds are not budgeted for this project, however, CIP Reserves are available. Staff proposes to use CIP Reserves to construct the repairs in 2014 and then include the costs in the 2015 CIP.
