## MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, September 23, 2014

**Council Meeting:** The City Council meeting came to order at 7:10 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Pledge:** The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Invocation:** Alderman Lidell gave an Invocation.

**Roll Call:** Roll call was taken with Mayor Raes, Aldermen Knaack, Parker, Bender, Zelnio, Turner, Schoonmaker, Liddell and Acri present. Absent: None.

### **Second Reading Ordinances**

#### **1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3019-2014**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20 "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 14 thereof, "FIFTEEN-MINUTE PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN NONMETERED ZONES," by deleting Fifteenth Street, on both sides, from Fifth Avenue to Sixth Avenue, and adding in lieu thereof Fifteenth Street, on both sides, from Fifth Avenue south to the alley.

#### **2. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3020-2014**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20 "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 18 thereof, "TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN NONMETERED ZONES," by including 15<sup>th</sup> Street, on the east side, from 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue north to the first alley.

#### **3. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3021-2014**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-5124, "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES; A VIOLATION," Appendix 24, "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES," by including one on-street stall at 403 – 43<sup>rd</sup> Street.

#### **4. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4042-2014**

A Special Ordinance closing certain streets more particularly described herein to vehicular traffic and authorizing the use of public right-of-way in conjunction with the Moline High School Homecoming Parade scheduled for Friday, October 3, 2014.

#### **5. Council Bill/Resolution 1137-2014**

A Resolution authorizing the purchase of Six Compressed Natural Gas Maintenance Vehicles from Currie Motors Ford in Frankfort, Illinois for \$213,960.00.

**First Reading Ordinances****6. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3022-2014**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20 "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 10 thereof, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME," by including 41<sup>st</sup> Street, on the east side, from 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue south for a distance of 50 feet.

**7. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3023-2014**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20 "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 10 thereof, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME," by including 13<sup>st</sup> Street, on the east side, from 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue south for a distance of 25 feet.

**8. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4044-2014**

A Special Ordinance closing certain streets more particularly described herein to vehicular traffic and authorizing the use of public right-of-way in conjunction with the Unity Point Quad Cities Classic Rowing Regatta scheduled for Saturday, October 11, 2014.

**9. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4045-2014**

A Special Ordinance closing certain streets more particularly described herein to vehicular traffic and authorizing the use of public right-of-way in conjunction with the Running Dead 5K scheduled for Saturday, October 11, 2014.

**10. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4046-2014**

A Special Ordinance suspending Section 23-2102(c)(7) of Chapter 23, PARKS AND RECREATION," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, temporarily, as it relates to the sale, possession and consumption of alcohol; and authorizing the Mayor/Local Liquor Control Commissioner and the City Clerk to permit the sale, possession and consumption of alcohol on municipal property during the Running Dead 5K to be held along River Drive/Ben Butterworth Parkway, Moline, Illinois, on October 11, 2014.

**Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:**

Lee Ann Fisher, Library Director, stated that Sunday attendance has been very successful.

Alderman Knaack asked if the Administration granted permission for City owned property to be used for a political campaign commercial featuring a Moline firefighter. Lew Steinbrecher, City Administrator, stated that permission was not given. Alderman Knaack asked for staff to research the policy on this.

Ron Miller, Resident, stated that he has concerns about ISO ratings.

On motion of Alderman Knaack, Seconded by Alderman Parker, Council adjourned at 7:18 p.m.
