MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 6:38 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: Alderman Bender gave an Invocation.

Roll Call: Roll call was taken with Mayor Raes, Aldermen Knaack, Parker, Bender, Zelnio, Schoonmaker, Liddell and Acri present. Absent: Alderman Turner

Items on Consent:

Approval of Minutes

Omnibus Vote: Alderman Knaack, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Knaack, Parker, Bender, Zelnio, Schoonmaker, Liddell and Acri; nays: none.

Items Not on Consent:

First Reading Ordinances

1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3026-2014

An Ordinance amending Chapter 15, "GARBAGE AND TRASH," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Sec. 15-2102, "CURBSIDE RECYCLING CARTS," by repealing subsection (b) in its entirety and enacting in lieu thereof one new subsection (b) relating to the same subject matter; and amending Sec. 15-2200, "FEE FOR RESIDENTIAL REFUSE COLLECTION," by repealing Section 15-2200 in its entirety and enacting in lieu thereof one new Section 15-2200 related to the same subject matter.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

Alderman Zelnio asked if there were any programs to help a resident with driveway/sidewalk repair. Mike Waldron, Public Works Director, stated that there is a 75/25 sidewalk repair program. Ray Forsythe, Planning & Development Director, stated that there also may be matching funds available from CDBG.

Alderman Zelnio requested information regarding the retaining wall on 12th Street near the John Deere House. Lew Steinbrecher, City Administrator, stated that the City has funds budgeted to repair the wall; however, it has not been allowed legal access to the property and is currently awaiting judgment. The debris in the sidewalk has been left to deter using the sidewalk because the wall is unstable.

On motion of Alderman Knaack, Seconded by Alderman Parker, Council adjourned at 6:38 p.m.
