Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 6:40 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: Alderman Knaack gave an Invocation.

Resolutions

1. Council Bill/Resolution 1001-2015

A Resolution authorizing approval of a Reconciliation Change Order with Treiber Construction Company for Project No. 1202, 2014 Pavement Patching Program, in the amount of \$282,073.87.

Omnibus Vote: Alderman Knaack, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Knaack, Parker, Triebel, Zelnio, Turner, Schoonmaker, Liddell and Acri; nays: none.

Ray Forsythe, Planning & Development Director, stated that the City is partnering with the Moline School District in marketing the Garfield School property.

Alderman Knaack expressed appreciation to the street crews for the snow removal.

Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Parker, Triebel, Zelnio, Turner and Schoonmaker; nays: Alderman Knaack and Acri; abstention: Alderman Liddell due to sole candidacy in the Consolidated Election.
