The position will be eliminated through attrition, and any additional costs incurred will be absorbed in the existing Fire Department budget.

A SPECIAL ORDINANCE

CLOSING certain streets more particularly described herein to vehicular traffic; and

AUTHORIZING the use of public right-of-way in conjunction with “Gabe’s Gift Memorial 5K & 1 Mile Fun Run” scheduled for Saturday, August 22, 2015.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1 – That this Council hereby authorizes and directs the Mayor, Director of Public Works and Police Chief to erect barricades and post temporary signs, if necessary, for the purpose of closing the following designated roadways to vehicular traffic during the specified times mentioned herein:

Saturday, August 22, 2015, from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.

The easternmost northbound lane of 53rd Street from the northernmost westbound lane of 38th Avenue to the southernmost side of 34th Avenue.

The southernmost eastbound lane of 34th Avenue from the easternmost northbound lane of 53rd Street to the westernmost southbound lane of 70th Street.

The westernmost southbound lane of 70th Street from the southernmost eastbound lane of 34th Avenue to the northernmost westbound lane of 37th Avenue.

The northernmost westbound lane of 38th Avenue from the westernmost southbound lane of 70th Street to the easternmost northbound lane of 53rd Street.

It shall be an offense to use said roadways for vehicular purposes during said time.

Section 2 – That this Council declares the intent of this ordinance to be a temporary variance from other ordinances that may be in conflict herewith and shall authorize the activities described hereinabove only during such times specified for the street closings and shall not constitute a repeal of other ordinances of the City of Moline which are in conflict herewith.

Section 3 – That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval, and if required by law, publication in the manner provided for by law.

AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-5124, "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES; A VIOLATION," Appendix 24, "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES," by including one on-street stall at 737 14th Street.

WHEREAS, a request was received and reviewed by the Traffic Committee on August 4, 2015; and

WHEREAS, the request meets the criteria for designating such a space.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

Section 1 – That Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-5124, "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES; A VIOLATION," Appendix 24, "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES," is hereby amended to include the following when appropriate signs are posted:

One on-street stall at 737 14th Street.

Section 2 – That pursuant to Section 1-1107 of the Moline Code of Ordinances, any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not more than seven hundred fifty dollars (\$750.00) for each offense.

Section 3 – That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval, and if required by law, publication in the manner provided for by law.
