MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, January 5, 2016

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 6:36 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Second Reading Ordinances

1. **Council Bill/General Ordinance 3053-2015**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 10 thereof, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME," by including 3rd Street, on the west side, from 23rd Avenue south to 2nd Street.

2. **Council Bill/General Ordinance 3054-2015**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-5124, "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES; A VIOLATION," Appendix 24, "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES," by including one on-street stall at 1511 10th Avenue.

3. **Council Bill/General Ordinance 3055-2015**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 2 thereof, "LEFT TURN RESTRICTION INTERSECTION," by including 7th Street at 32nd Avenue, westbound turning southbound from 2:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m., on school days.

4. **Council Bill/General Ordinance 3056-2015**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-5124, "UNAUTHORIZED PERSONS USING PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES; A VIOLATION," Appendix 24, "PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES PARKING SPACES," by removing one on-street stall at the following locations: 810 17th Avenue; 1611 20th Avenue; 1846 10th Street; and 2410 18th Avenue.

5. **Council Bill/Resolution 1001-2016**

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute Licensing Agreements for 2016 permit approved applications for use of public right-of-way or City-owned property.

6. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4001-2016

A Special Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Consent Agreement between the City of Moline and GTP Acquisition Partners II, LLC to permit a modification of equipment for AT&T Mobility for City-owned property located at 4213 16th Avenue.

7. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4002-2016

A Special Ordinance authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a lease agreement with Moline Little League for the purpose of maintaining and hosting sanctioned Little League games and tournaments, for a lease term of January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2020.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

Sandy O'Neill, 1604 11th Avenue, stated that she is concerned about the Moline Public Library being closed on Sundays. Bryon Lear, Library Coordinator, indicated that this is a decision made by the Library Board and that he would speak with her after the Council meeting with further details.

Mary McDowell stated that she disagrees with an ambulance bill that she received. Lew Steinbrecher, City Administrator, indicated that Kim Hankins, Public Safety Director, would speak with her after the meeting.
