#### **Approval of Minutes**

#### **2. Council Bill/Resolution 1145-2016**

**A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Second Amendment to Agreement between the City of Moline and the Quad Cities Chamber of Commerce, Inc. related to the administration of the Moline Centre Main Street Program and coordination of the maintenance and landscaping requirements for Special Service Areas #5 and #6.**
