Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 7:09 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

1. Council Bill/Resolution 1178-2012

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to apply for a highway permit and execute the necessary forms in conjunction with the "Komen Quad Cities Race for the Cure" scheduled for Saturday, June 9, 2012.

2. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4018-2012

A Special Ordinance closing certain streets more particularly described herein to vehicular traffic and authorizing the use of public right-of-way in conjunction with the Komen Quad Cities Race for the Cure 5K, 1.2 ML Run/Walk Special Event scheduled for Saturday, June 9, 2012.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

Michael P. Waldron, Public Works Director, explained that staff is taking many calls regarding storm water drainage due to all of the heavy rain over the last week.

Ray Forsythe, Planning & Economic Development Director, announced that Moline Centre Main Street received the Young Professional Networks "Hot Spot" award for the innovative improvements made to a downtown area.

Alderman Raes, seconded by Alderman Liddell, made a motion to direct staff to bring a recommendation regarding ambulance fees back for Council to review. Motion passed unanimously.
