**First Reading Ordinances**

**1. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4019-2012**

A Special Ordinance authorizing approval of private drive and address designations for both the former KONE, Inc. property and the new KONE Centre; and repealing Resolution No. 304-99 (Council Bill No. 99-288) in its entirety.

**Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:**

Mayor Welvaert indicated that he would be in Springfield the next day in order to participate in a press conference urging the State of Illinois legislators to vote against the State of Illinois House Bill 3637, regarding the Corporate Replacement Tax.
