Explanation: Illinois State Statute provides that law enforcement agencies may seize vehicles used during the attempt or commission of specific crimes and subsequently initiate forfeiture proceedings on those vehicles. The below listed vehicles were seized and forfeited to the police department, and staff is requesting that they be declared as surplus property and disposed of by the Finance Director through the legal disposal process that is most advantageous to the City, whether sealed bid, auction, negotiation or otherwise: 1999 Cadillac Eldorado VIN# 1G6EL12Y5XU615560; 2003 Chevy Tahoe VIN# 1GNEK13Z23J210993.
