Salvage Reuse

Many kinds of building materials are available for reuse including:

- Dimensional lumber, including beams, studs, plywood, and trusses
- Doors, flooring, drywall, concrete (ground and reusable as aggregate), and bricks
- Plumbing and lighting fixtures of all kinds
- Unique and antique products that may no longer be available, such as rare woods, cabinetry, and

Wanted Materials:

Used and surplus materials, fixtures, tools and supplies:

- Appliances—refrigerators, stoves, washers, dryers
- Cabinets
- Countertops
- Plumbing, usable fixtures, parts and supplies
- Electrical, usable fixtures, parts and supplies
- Windows
- Hardware, knobs, hinges, locks, nails, cabinet pulls, nuts, bolts, screws
- Lumber, dimensional and sheet (at least 4' in length)
- Roofing
- New Carpeting
- Paint—latex only
- Tools, hand, garden, power
- Flooring, wood, ceramic tile, vinyl
- Millwork/Trim
- Miscellaneous Masonry, sheathing, siding, drywall supplies

Ways To Become More Green

- Consider leaving concrete exposed, using it as a finish material
- For remodels and redevelopment, allow time in your schedule for deconstruction and recycling.
- Avoid use of inefficient fixtures, components, and appliances
- Use toilets with less than 1.6 gallons per flush
- Avoid using single-pane windows
- Reuse materials on site for other projects

Benefits of Salvaged Building Materials

- Reduces landfill waste
- Low embodied energy
- Local availability
- Aesthetically pleasing historic materials
- Reduces the impact from harvesting and mining for original materials such as logs, tropical hardwood trees and mining metals
