More than **24 billion gallons** of the stormwater in the Quad Cities enters the Mississippi & Rock Rivers *each year*



All of Moline's stormwater empties into the local rivers, *none of it goes to a treatment plant.*



There are over **102 miles** of stormwater pipes in Moline, enough to run to Galesburg and back!



The Mississippi River Basin drains **over 40%** of the entire continental United States, including 31 states and 2 Canadian Provinces.



The Rock River drains over **10,000 square miles** of land in Wisconsin and Illinois, bigger than the entire state of Vermont!



The City of Moline's drinking water has come from the Mississippi River for **125 years!**



The Mississippi River is 3 feet deep at its headwaters in Minnesota and over **200 feet deep** in New Orleans. It travels 2,552 miles to reach the Gulf of Mexico.
