Set up and clean up time must be included in the rental time. Call 309-524-2424 for availability and reserve for your party today!

Rental Times:

Fridays: between 5:00 - 10:00 p.m.

Saturdays & Sundays: between 1:00 - 10:00 p.m.

** Due to COVID-19 we are only having one rental per day to allow time for proper cleaning*

Fees:

\$50 per hour (3 hour minimum)

\$100 damage deposit

* All fees due at the time of reservation

Cellar Rules

1. NO: SMOKING, ALCOHOL, ILLEGAL DRUGS OR DRUG PARAPHANALIA PERMITTED INSIDE OR OUTSIDE OF THIS BUILDING.
2. Safety is a primary concern here at the Cellar. Fighting, pushing, horseplay, running, etc. will not be tolerated.
3. Inappropriate or offensive language is not acceptable at this facility.
4. No sitting on the equipment i.e. table games, stereo equipment, etc.
5. No food or drink on any of the equipment.
6. No hanging on the overhead pipes.
7. Please throw trash in the trash cans and not on the floor.
8. Do not bring any objects into the facility that could be used as a weapon.
9. A "hands off" policy is in place at the cellar; holding hands, arm and arm, sitting in lap, hugging, kissing are not appropriate while at the cellar. This will not be tolerated.
10. Any form of gambling will not be tolerated.
11. Please do not steal objects from the cellar.

Cellar Usage Information: Thank you for reserving the Cellar. In order to ensure that your rental is satisfactory, all functions conducted at the Cellar must be in accordance with the Cellar rules listed above, Moline City Ordinance and the following instructions/restrictions.

Usage Instructions/Restrictions

1. Table and wall decorations may be used. Please use tape or putty to attach decorations.
2. Please do not mark on the walls, floors, ceiling, doors, tables or any other surface.
3. Alcohol is not allowed in the cellar. This is a Moline City Ordinance and violators of this ordinance are subject to arrest. The renter is responsible for ensuring that no alcohol enters the facility.
4. Gambling is not allowed at the Cellar. This is a Moline City Ordinance and violators of this ordinance are subject to arrest. The renter is responsible for ensuring that no gambling takes place in the Cellar.
5. The renter is responsible for the following at the conclusion of the rental 1) pick up all loose trash and dispose in the trash cans. 2) All pieces of equipment for table games must be returned to the site supervisor. 3) Tables will need to be wiped down. 4) Bathrooms must be picked up, flush all urinals and toilets. * Site supervisor can provide you with any cleaning supplies.

Damage Deposit

Your Cellar damage deposit will be refunded via check within 4 weeks of your rental if you paid via check or cash OR back on to your credit/debit card originally used to reserve. The following situations will result in forfeiture of your deposit.

1. The entire deposit will be retained if there is any evidence of alcohol is reported or found in the facility.
2. The damage deposit will be retained in whole or part of, if there is a violation of any of the Cellar rules, usage restrictions or Moline City Ordinances.
3. Failure to clean the facility or leaving it in a condition which requires more cleaning than normal will result in the loss of a portion of your deposit depending on the condition of the facility.
4. Any physical damage to the Cellar, other than normal wear and tear, as determined by the Moline Parks and Recreation Department will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.
5. Any damages or misuse exceeding the damage deposit will result in a charge for restoration and may also result in denial of future rental privileges.
