



Adopt-A-Street Program Expectations

Adopt-A-Street sponsors provide a valuable service to the City of Moline and we honor them for their commitment and dedication to keeping Moline streets clean and presentable for our residents and those who visit us.

Sponsors are asked to clean their adopted street right-of-way at least four times a year - once in the spring, once in the fall, and two other times as needed.

Items needed for cleaning are provided by the City: trash bags for debris collection, safety vests, and gloves. These items may be picked up at the City of Moline Public Works Building located at 3635 4th Avenue, Moline.

We ask that you please call Public Works at 309.524.2345 at least (2) days prior to your clean-up so City staff can have supplies ready for pick up.

You are advised not to have unsupervised minors helping and to exercise extreme caution when working near traffic. Always wear your vest and gloves, and have traffic signage in place during your clean-up.

Any items found on the right-of-way that are either too large for collection such as tires, or are beyond your abilities to collect or remove, such as a dead animal, should be reported to Public Works for removal. Full trash bags can be left on the street corners of the area cleaned, but should be reported to Public Works for collection.
