Mike Waldron called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

1. **Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of December 3, 2013.** Motion to approve minutes by Allen, seconded by DeVrieze. Motion carried unanimously.
2. **Request to place a four-way stop at 11th Avenue B and 29th Street.** Committee members discussed the lack of traffic that travels west from 11th Avenue B onto 29th Street. According to Committee members, this intersection is not currently considered a dangerous intersection. Residents living here have access to an alley giving them an alternate means of travel. Motion to deny request by Mathias, seconded by DeVrieze. Motion carried unanimously.

Other:

Sergeant DeVrieze received a request to consider removal or reconsider location of "no parking this side of street" on east side of 31st Street between 12th Avenue and 11th Avenue C. Based on the width of the street, parking is prohibited on one side of 31st Street. Committee concluded that the sign is placed to allow patrons better access to businesses located here. Motion to keep current location of sign and add the "no parking this side of street" sign on the east side of 31st Street between 12th Avenue and 11th Avenue C to the Moline Code of Ordinances by Hinton, seconded by Mathias. Motion carried unanimously.

Committee received a request for a "no parking from here to corner" sign at 5024 10th Avenue. Members discussed the lack of parking in the cul-de-sac and surrounding streets near 5024 10th Avenue. This area of Moline does not have alleys either making parking harder to find. Motion to deny request by Mathias, seconded by Hinton. Motion carried unanimously.

Committee received a request for a stop sign, in Mollette, at the entrance of 40th Street Court from 37th Street. Hinton discussed that both stop and yield signs are not required at all intersections. In the case of 40th Street Court and 37th Street, 40th Street Court would have right-of-way over 37th Street. Although a sign is not required, members still discussed the need for a sign at this intersection. Motion to place a stop sign northeast bound on 37th Street at the intersection of 40th Street Court by Waldron, seconded by Allen. Motion passed with the following vote: Ayes: Waldron, Allen, and Mathias. Nays: Hinton and DeVrieze.

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by Hinton. Meeting adjourned at 2:10 p.m.
