Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of July 7, 2015.** Motion to approve minutes by Waldron, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request for a residential handicap parking space at 737 14<sup>th</sup> Street.** Medina attended on behalf of agenda item two. Medina stated that parking is limited near 737 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Medina has no parking in the rear of her property and no level parking nearby. Christ suggested that Medina add a parking space to the rear of 737 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Pickens stated that 737 14<sup>th</sup> Street had limited space for installing a parking space. Motion to approve the installation of a residential handicap parking space at 737 14<sup>th</sup> Street by Pickens, seconded by Waldron. Motion carried with the following votes: Ayes: Waldron, Hinton, and Pickens. Nays: Christ.
- 3. Request for a 3-way stop at 53<sup>rd</sup> Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue.** Waldron suggested adding signage to inform drivers of the crosswalks located at 53<sup>rd</sup> Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Committee agreed that a 3-way stop is not warranted. Raes suggested moving the crosswalks closer to the former church. Hinton informed staff that moving the crosswalks would force pedestrians to cross driveways along 53<sup>rd</sup> Street. Committee agreed that a mid-block crosswalk would be dangerous. Motion to deny request and add "crosswalk here" signs to 53<sup>rd</sup> Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion carried with the following votes: Ayes: Waldron, Pickens, and Christ. Nays: Hinton.

**Other:** Mayor Raes questioned whether the new construction on 26th Avenue, west of 18th Street A, should be signed as a no parking zone.

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by Pickens. Meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
