Mike Waldron called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of December 1, 2015.** Motion to approve minutes by Versluis, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to install traffic signals at 7th Street & 16th Avenue.** Committee collectively agreed that they would rather have pedestrians cross at a 4-way stop than a signaled intersection. Motion to deny request by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Request to install signage or additional lane markings to inform drivers that 12th Avenue is a one lane road, eastbound, between 34th Street and 36th Street Court.** Committee agreed that the signage and lane markings at 34th Street and 12th Avenue are visible and clearly marked. Residents living near said location have driveways that they can park their vehicles in. Motion to deny additional signage unless the Engineering Division believes additional signage is needed by Christ, seconded by Waldron. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Request to install “no parking from here to alley” signs on 12th Avenue at 1712 12th Avenue and 1718 12th Avenue.** Committee agreed that the alley in question was no different than any other alley in Moline and concluded that a sign was not warranted. Motion to deny by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Request to install bike lanes on 34th Street, between 4th Avenue and 23rd Avenue.** Motion to table request until Committee can gather more information on installing bike lanes between River Drive and 12th Avenue by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion carried with the following votes: Ayes: Pickens, Christ, Waldron, and Klauer. Nays: Versluis.

Other: Raes received a request to install a handicap parking space at the Yankee Doodle (2401 16th Street). Since this is private property, Committee called Joe Mason (Building Official) into the meeting to report the businesses lack of handicap parking. Mason will contact business owner to solve issue.

Request to remove a residential handicap parking space at 1150 14th Avenue by Waldron, seconded by Versluis. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by Versluis. Meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
