2. Request to prohibit parking on 26th Avenue A, south side, between 12th Street and 13th Street.

Explanation: Resident has requested that the City prohibit parking on the south side of 26th Avenue A so that drivers can exit 13th Street onto 26th Avenue A. Residents living nearby are unable to use 26th Avenue A when vehicles are parked on both sides of the avenue.

3. Request for a residential handicap parking space at 1111 26th Avenue.

Explanation: Resident has requested that a handicap parking space is installed on 25th Avenue Ct to allow them to easily access their home at 1111 26th Avenue. Due to disability, resident is unable to utilize 26th Avenue to access home.

4. Request to remove a residential handicap parking space at 149 6th Avenue and install a residential handicap parking space at 162 6th Avenue.

Explanation: Resident has requested that a handicap parking space is removed at 149 6th Avenue and installed at 162 6th Avenue.

5. Request to prohibit truck traffic on 15th Street A, north of 23rd Avenue.

Explanation: Resident stated that tree branches are often hit by large trucks that use 15th Street A. Resident would like to put a “no thru truck traffic” sign on the corner of 15th Street A and 23rd Avenue to prohibit trucks from using 15th Street A.

6. Request to grant Seton School permission to cut into the curb on the south side of 16th Avenue, between 13th and 14th Street, to create parking on 16th Avenue.

Explanation: Seton School has requested permission to cut into the curb on 16th Avenue, between 13th and 14th Street, to create parking on 16th Avenue. Parking is currently prohibited on both sides of 16th Avenue, between 13th and 14th Street.

7. Request to install a “no parking from here to corner” sign on the west side of 18th Street B near the intersection of 25th Avenue.

Explanation: Resident stated that vehicles park too close to the corner of 25th Avenue and 18th Street B causing a blind corner for drivers. Resident has requested that a “no parking form here to corner sign” is installed on the west side of 18th Street B so that drivers can see vehicles traveling on 25th Avenue.

8. Request to install “no parking on Tuesday’s between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.” signage in front of 1814 15th Avenue and 1818 15th Avenue.

Explanation: Doug House, Municipal Services General Manager, has requested that the City install signage to help alleviate issues with Sanitation Services in the alley between 14th and 15th Avenue. Sanitation drivers have a difficult time turning onto the alley to pick up garbage when vehicles park in front of 1814 15th Avenue and 1818 15th Avenue. Mr. House believes that eliminating parking from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on garbage day will help solve Sanitation Service issues.
