Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:35 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of February 2, 2016.** Motion to approve minutes by Versluis, seconded by Waldron. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request for two-hour parking in front of 2401 40th Avenue.** Request was tabled from the February Traffic Engineering Committee. Waldron stated that he believed that the parking issue at 2401 40th Avenue was between Ms. Kerker and her landlord. Motion to deny request by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion carried with the following votes: Ayes: Pickens, Christ, Waldron, and Hinton. Nays: Versluis. In addition, Committee discussed a request to permit parking one side of 24th Street and one side of 40th Avenue. Kurek informed Committee of possible parking options. Hinton informed Committee that he was not in favor of lane sharing on commercially zoned roads. Motion to leave Ordinance as is and install additional no parking signs by Waldron, seconded by Versluis. Motion carried with the following votes: Ayes: Pickens, Versluis, Waldron, and Hinton. Nays: Christ
- 3. Request to permit parking on 48th Street, west side, north of 12th Avenue.** Pickens spoke with the Principal and Liaison Officer at Wilson Middle School to confirm that it would not be an issue to allow parking on the west side of 48th Street. The Principal and Liaison Officer did not have any issues permitting parking on 48th Street. Christ informed Committee that 48th Street is wide enough to allow parking on both sides. Motion to allow parking on the west side of 48th Street, between 11th Avenue A and 12th Avenue, by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously. Committee agreed that a “no parking from here to corner” sign would need to be installed 30 feet from 12th Avenue to prevent vehicles from parking near intersection.
- 4. Request to install a “no parking here to corner sign” on the north side of 23rd Avenue B at 27th Street.** Committee members agreed that they did not see a line-of-sight issue at 27th Street and 23rd Avenue B. Pickens stated that a vehicle would have to be in the intersection to cause a line-of-sight issue. Motion to deny by Waldron, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Request to discuss the installation of sharrows on 34th Street, between 4th Avenue and 23rd Avenue.** Hinton informed staff that 34th Street does not have adequate lane width to install sharrows. If sharrows were installed, parking would need to be removed on both sides of 34th Street. Waldron requested that staff members find an alternative bike route between 23rd Avenue to River Drive. Motion to withdraw request for sharrows on 34th Street, between 23rd Avenue and 4th Avenue, by Waldron.

Other:

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 2:15 p.m.
