2. Request to grant Seton School permission to cut into the curb on the south side of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue to create parking.

**Explanation:** Request was tabled from last month's Traffic Engineering Committee. Seton School has requested permission to cut into the curb on 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue to create parking between 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> Street. Parking is currently prohibited on both sides of 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue in said location.

3. Request to close 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, between 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and 24<sup>th</sup> Street, on school days, between 3:30 and 3:45 p.m. and install a flashing light.

**Explanation:** Temple Christian School (2305 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue) has requested that the City closes 7<sup>th</sup> Avenue, between 23<sup>rd</sup> Street and 24<sup>th</sup> Street, to allow for the safe dismissal of students. Temple Christian School has requested that said location is closed between 3:30 and 3:45 p.m. on school days. Vehicles often travel over the 20 mph speed limit causing a dangerous situation for Temple Christian Students.

4. Request to prohibit a section of parking on the east side of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street across from the driveway located at the residence of 1165 23<sup>rd</sup> Street.

**Explanation:** The resident of 1165 23<sup>rd</sup> Street has requested to prohibit parking on the east side of 23<sup>rd</sup> Street across from the driveway of her residence. Resident has complications backing out of the driveway when a vehicle is parked at said location.

5. Request to prohibit parking along 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue in front of a future shelter location at 338 6<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Explanation:** Metrolink has requested to prohibit parking along 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue in front of a future shelter location near the Boys and Girls club Administration Center, 338 6<sup>th</sup> Street. Metrolink is working with Global Communities to provide more shelter infrastructure in Floreciente and have identified this location for a shelter install. Without a parking restriction, busses are unable to deploy their ramps for individuals with disabilities. Parking in said location would also prohibit buses from pulling out of the traffic lane to board/deboard.
