Agenda Items

1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of December 6, 2011.

1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee Meeting of December 6, 2011.

2. Request to change loading zone hours from 8 until 6 at Jerry's Market, 1609 17th Street.

Explanation: Jerry's Market, 1609 17th Street, currently has a loading zone sign posted with the hours 8 until 4. He would like it to be 8 until 6 when his store closes. The neighbors start parking there after 4 and it makes deliveries difficult.

3. Request that the one-way on 16th Avenue between 16th and 17th Streets (part-time during school hours) be changed so the one-way flow would run from west to east.

Explanation: Jerry's Market, 1609 17th Street, is requesting that the one-way on 16th Avenue between 16th and 17th Streets (part-time during school hours) be changed so the one-way flow would run from west to east. There is a full-time one-way on 16th Avenue between 15th and 16th Streets and that one runs west to east so people could continue in that direction to his store.

4. Request to have a left turn lane for the north bound cars on 7th Street at Valley View Drive.

Explanation: On 7th Street there is a marked left turn lane for southbound traffic turning east on 38th Avenue, but there is no left turn lane for northbound traffic turning west onto Valley View Drive. There is a lane that is marked with yellow lanes indicated closed for traffic that causes confusion as some cars use it as a left turn lane and others don't which, at times, leads to two cars turning from both lanes.

5. Request to have a stop sign on Valley View Drive at the "t" intersection.

Explanation: There is a stop sign for traffic heading south, but it is not very visible and cars do not stop.
