Informational Items

1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of May 3, 2016.

2. Request to install a 4-way stop at 14th Street and 18th Avenue.

Explanation: Request to remove yield signs at 14th Street and 18th Avenue and install a 4-way stop. Resident stated that vehicles speed through this intersection.

3. Request to install a 4-way stop at 25th Street and 39th Avenue.

Explanation: Due to concern for pedestrian traffic, Thomas VanBaale has requested that a 4-way stop is installed at 39th Avenue and 25th Street. Mr. VanBaale also believes that there is a line of sight issue because of the car lots and occasional metro link bus traffic.

4. Request to remove the stop signs located east and westbound at 26th Street and 39th Avenue.

Explanation: Resident believes that if the 4-way stop was added at 39th Avenue and 26th Street the stop signs could be removed at 26th Street and 39th Avenue.

5. Request to install a 4-way stop at 25th Street and 19th Avenue.

Explanation: Due to line-of-sight issues, a resident has requested that a 4-way stop is installed at 25th Street and 19th Avenue. Drivers tend to park their vehicles near the intersection making it difficult for drivers to see.

6. Request to install a handicap parking space at 1625 9th Avenue.

Explanation: Ms. Berg has requested that a handicap sign is installed at 1625 9th Avenue. Ms. Berg plans on installing a wheelchair ramp in the front her home. The homeowner's son cannot access home in his wheelchair because of the series of steps it take to get into the house from the garage.
