Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of March 1, 2016.** Motion to approve minutes by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to prohibit parking on 26th Avenue A, south side, between 12th Street and 13th Street.** Hinton stated that 26th Avenue A is not wide enough to allow parking on both sides. Parking is not currently an issue on the north side of 26th Avenue A. Motion to approve by Kurek, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Request for a residential handicap parking space at 1111 26th Avenue.** Request was made by a tenant living at 1111 26th Avenue. Tenant is only able to access home from 25th Avenue Ct. Motion to approve by Christ. Motion failed for lack of a second. Kurek stated that he felt it was the responsibility of the homeowner to provide ADA access for the tenant.
- 4. Request to remove a handicap parking space at 149 6th Avenue and install a residential handicap parking space at 162 6th Avenue.** Pickens stated that the homeowner that needed the handicap parking space at 149 6th Avenue no longer lives at 149 6th Avenue. Motion to remove handicap parking space by Pickens, seconded by Allen. Motion carried unanimously. Hinton informed staff that the distance between the street and 162 6th Avenue is the same as the distance from homeowner's garage. Motion to deny request by Pickens, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously.
- 5. Request to prohibit truck traffic on 15th Street A, north of 23rd Avenue.** A resident has requested that truck traffic be prohibited on 15th Street A to prevent tree branches from getting hit. The City of Moline Parks Department trimmed trees on 15th Street A to alleviate the problem. Committee agreed that the trimming solved the issues on 15th Street A. Motion to deny request by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 6. Request to grant Seton School permission to cut into the curb on the south side of 16th Avenue, between 13th and 14th street, to create parking on 16th Avenue.** Pickens suggested speaking with Seton staff members to discuss alternative options prior to voting. Motion to table request until next month's Traffic Committee by Allen, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 7. Request to install a "no parking from here to corner" sign on 18th Street B near the intersection of 25th Avenue.** Christ and Raes informed Committee that they both witnessed a line of sight issue here. Motion to install a no parking sign 40 feet from 25th Avenue by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.

- 8. Request to install “no parking on Tuesday’s between 7:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m.” signage in front of 1814 15th Avenue and 1818 15th Avenue.** Doug House, Municipal Services General Manager, spoke on behalf of item. The Sanitation Division has been having issues accessing the alley north of 18th Street from both 14th and 15th Avenue. House stated that the Sanitation vehicles cannot make the turn onto said alley when vehicles are parked in the trucks turning radius. Allen reported that this change would also benefit the fire department. Committee members collectively agreed with House. Motion to prohibit parking on 14th Avenue and 15th Avenue, south side, at the entrance of the alley east of 18th Street, for a distance that would allow Sanitation vehicles to turn onto alley by Christ, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously.

Other:

Motion to adjourn by Christ, seconded by Allen. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
