Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes for the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of December 5, 2017.** Motion to approve minutes by Versluis, seconded by Klauer. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to consider a time limitation, either one or two hour limit, on 18th Avenue.** Committee discussed that 18th Avenue has businesses and residential on 18th Avenue between 7th and 8th Street. Currently signed with three signs that identify 2 hour parking. Committee agrees that current signage is confusing, but the Police Department will enforce when called. Motion to approve two hour parking limit on 18th Avenue from 7th Street to existing 2 hour parking sign with Engineering to provide measurements. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Request to prohibit parking along 23rd Avenue (Avenue of the Cities) between 1st and 7th Street.** Committee discussed that vehicles are able to pass with cars parked at this location and didn't feel the change is warranted. Motion to deny request by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Request to change from a left-turn lane for southbound traffic only to a two-way left-turn lane at 7th Street and 33rd Avenue.** Committee discussed that cars should not be blocking the intersection and like how it is currently striped. Motion to extend center turn lane like it was before Hamilton school construction by Versluis. Motion died due to lack of second. Motion to deny request and keep striped as is by Klauer, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Christ, seconded by Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
