Mike Waldron called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of May 1, 2012.** Motion by Waldron to approve minutes, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to place stop signs on 4th Street at 4th Street and 30th Avenue Court.** Committee discussed that current signage is appropriate for the intersection and having the tree trimmed that is causing the line of sight issue. Motion to deny request by DeVrieze, seconded by Waldron. Motion carried unanimously. Shawn Christ to follow up on having the tree trimmed.
- 3. Request to place a sign warning that the railroad tracks are rough at 19th Street and 4th Avenue.** Motion by Waldron to have staff contact the railroad to see if they have any plans on repairing the crossing at this location in the near future. If there are no plans to repair the crossing, request that a rough crossing sign be placed on the signal, seconded Allen. Motion carried unanimously.

Other:

Request to install a traffic signal at the intersection of 34th Avenue and 75th Street. Committee discussed that the current signage is appropriate for the intersection. Motion by Waldron to deny request to install a traffic signal at the intersection of 34th Avenue and 75th Street. Motion carried unanimously.

Traffic Signal on 23rd Avenue at Aldi's and Hy-Vee. Committee discussed that we have received concerns in the past regarding this offset intersection at Aldi's and Hy-Vee. Moving the entrance to Aldi's to be across from Hy-Vee would be a possible solution.

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by DeVrieze. Meeting adjourned at 1:47 p.m.
