Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes of the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of July 3, 2012.** Motion by Waldron to approve minutes, seconded by DeVrieze. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to place two no parking signs in the residential area between 15th Street A and 10th and 11th Avenue.** Jan Erikson-Vroman is a landlord that owns property in this area attended the meeting. Overflow parking from the Moline High School Loft apartments creates line of sight issues and concerned in the winter months with road conditions. Committee discussed that this problem has come up before and parking is a premium in this area. Discussion also held the eliminating a few spaces might resolve some of the issues. Motion to deny request to place two no parking signs in the residential area between 15th Street A and 10th and 11th Avenue by Waldron, seconded by DeVrieze. Motion passed with the following vote: Ayes; Christ, Hinton, and Waldron. Nays: DeVrieze. Motion to prohibit parking on 15th Street A, north, to 10th Avenue. Motion passed with the following vote: Ayes; Christ, DeVrieze, Hinton. Nays: Waldron.
- 3. Request to place a stop or yield sign on 20th Avenue at the northeast corner of 20th Avenue and 18th Street C.** Motion to install a stop sign on the northeast corner of 20th Avenue and 18th Street C, westbound traffic, by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion passed with the following vote: Ayes; Christ, DeVrieze, Waldron. Nays: Hinton.
- 4. Request to place no parking on the north side of 16th Avenue at 3rd Street before the stop sign.** Motion to approve by Waldron, seconded by Christ. Motion carried unanimously. Committee discussed line of sight being an issue when cars are parked at this location.

Other:

Request for a residential handicap parking space at 4706 11th Avenue B. The Police Department received a request for a residential handicap parking space at 4706 11th Avenue B. Resident does not own a vehicle. Motion to deny by Waldron, seconded by DeVrieze. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by DeVrieze, seconded by Waldron. Meeting adjourned at 1:55 p.m.
