Scott Hinton called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes for the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of April 2, 2019.** Motion to approve minutes by Moore, seconded by Sgt. Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to install a stop sign at the intersection of 25th Avenue and 25th Avenue Court.** Resident has requested a stop sign at the intersection of 25th Avenue and 25th Avenue Court. Drivers exiting 25th Avenue onto 25th Avenue Court have an obstructed view of oncoming traffic from parked vehicles, causing safety concerns at this intersection. Staff recommends approving the request based on the unique intersection geometry and the line of sight concerns with cross traffic. Motion to approve request by Sgt. Pickens, seconded by Moore. Motion carried unanimously.
- 3. Other.** Request to install flashing beacons at the intersection of 15th Street and 23rd Avenue. Staff reviewed the request and have found no history of crashes at this intersection. Flashing lights are intended to help bring attention to stop signs but if people are unlawfully running the stop sign the flashers than are not effective. Motion to deny request by Moore, seconded by Sgt. Pickens. Motion carried unanimously.
- 4. Other.** Request for resident to purchase and install a “slow children playing sign” on our existing no parking poles. Staff feels that excessive signage is ignored by drivers. This sign specifically is a non-enforceable sign. There was no motion made, this request was brought before the committee for discussion purposes only.

Motion to adjourn by Scott Hinton, seconded by Sgt. Pickens. Motion carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 1:40 p.m.
