Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes for the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of August 27, 2019.** Motion to approve minutes by Moore, seconded by Regenwether. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request review the current traffic control at the intersection of 12th Avenue and 12th Street.** A review of accident history reports showed most of the accidents involved southbound vehicles approaching the intersection. It's likely that a large portion of these accidents could have been avoided if southbound vehicles also stopped at the intersection. Hinton and Ald. Parker discussed adding warning beacons instead of an all-way stop. Motion to have Moore investigate possible vehicle actuated traffic control solutions for advanced warning. Moore will report his findings to the Committee via email. Motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Other.** Ald. Parker requested to review the signage at the intersection of 15th Street and 23rd Avenue. The Committee previously denied the request due to traffic volumes but will follow up to see if any new accident history reports exist.

Motion to adjourn by Scott Hinton, seconded by Moore. Motion carried unanimously.
