Matt Moore called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

Agenda Items:

- 1. Approval of minutes for the Traffic Engineering Committee meeting of August 4, 2020.** Motion to approve minutes by Russell, seconded by Klauer. Motion carried unanimously.
- 2. Request to prohibit parking on the east side of 14th Street, on the north and south sides of 20th Avenue.** The Committee received a request from a resident that states vehicles are parking all the way up to the intersection, and they make it difficult to see cross traffic when traveling east or west bound on 20th Avenue. Motion to table this item and speak with the residents by Klauer, seconded by Russell. Motion passed unanimously.
- 3. Request to prohibit parking on 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue A, on the south side near the intersection of 19<sup>th</sup> Street.** The Committee received concerns from a resident about entering 11th Avenue A from 19th Street. The resident stated that when there are vehicles westbound on 11th Avenue A waiting to turn south onto 19th Street, there is not sufficient room for southbound 19th Street traffic to turn left onto 11th Avenue A due to parked vehicles. She is also concerned about how fast vehicles travel down the street. No motion was made because the issue was resolved due to a change in roadway construction staging.
- 4. Request to modify the westbound lane configuration at the intersection of 36th Avenue and 16th Street.** The Committee received a request to modify the lane configuration at this intersection. The resident would like to see the north westbound lane changed from a thru/right to a right turn only lane. The resident feels that drivers in the north westbound lane speed up to pass drivers in the south westbound lane when crossing through the intersection, as the roadway goes from two lanes to

one lane. Motion to table this item and review the accident history report by Klauer, seconded by Moore. Motion passed unanimously.

- 5. Request to install an additional stop sign on 5<sup>th</sup> Street between 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 23<sup>rd</sup> Avenue.** The Committee received a request to consider adding additional stop signs on 5<sup>th</sup> Street. The resident stated that more drivers are using 5<sup>th</sup> street because of the new configuration of 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and to avoid the light at the intersection of 7<sup>th</sup> Street and 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue, and are speeding down the road. The portable radar speed sign was installed at the 2100 block of 5th Street facing north. Motion to deny this request since data showed that vehicles were obeying the posted speed limits by Russell, seconded by Klauer. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion to adjourn by Matt Moore, seconded by Russell. Motion carried unanimously.
