7. Request for two, 15- minute parking spaces adjacent to 905 18th Ave. Request pulled from agenda.

Other:

Request to place a stop sign at the intersection of 36th Avenue and 75th Street. Resident feels that placing a stop sign on the north end of 75th Street and 36th Avenue would prevent drivers from speeding going into the 90 degree turn on 75th Street. Committee stated that because this request is located at the bottom of a hill, it would not be sufficient location for a stop sign. Motion to deny request by DeVrieze, seconded by Waldron. Motion carried unanimously.

Request to investigate the lane markings at 70th Street and John Deere Road. Resident stated that the lane markings going south when approaching from 70th St are not adequate once motorist has crossed the intersection. Committee stated that they are aware of the issue and intend to re-stripe this Spring.

Motion to adjourn by Waldron, seconded by Hinton. Meeting adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
