Dear Mayor Rayapati:

You may consider this your permission to temporarily close 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue at the intersection of 12<sup>th</sup> Street and 17<sup>th</sup> Street between the hours of 2:00 PM and 4:30 PM on Saturday, June 18, 2022. This temporary closure is for the purpose of holding **Unity Pride Parade** sponsored by the **QC Pride, Inc.**

The detour shall be as outline in the attached resolution.

The conditions and restrictions as noted in the Resolution, adopted by the City Council, and approved by the Mayor of the City of Moline the 24th day of May, Two Thousand and Twenty-two, are hereby made a part of this Letter of Authorization.

The Statutes provide for the issuance of a permit to a local governmental agency for this purpose. It is required; however, that there shall be explicit agreement by the agency that it will assume all liabilities and pay all claims for any damages which shall be occasioned by such closing and that said agreement shall be made a part of this permit. The Statutes further provide, under the terms of the permit, that the agency shall maintain efficient detours satisfactory to the Department around the portion of the closed highway which shall be marked conspicuously with directional signs.

Contingent upon your acceptance of these Statutory requirements, this permit authorizes you to close the above-mentioned State highways within the time and limits shown. The following special regulations become a part of this permit:

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1. All material and supplies required for barricades, detour signs, etc., shall be provided by the local governmental agency.
2. Parking of vehicles should be prohibited on the detour streets to allow uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.
3. Barricades with "**ROAD CLOSED**" signs shall be erected at each end of the closed section.
4. A flagman or police officer should be stationed at each end of the closed section and at such other points as may be necessary to assist in directing through-traffic around the detour.
5. All debris shall be cleared away and disposed of by the local authorities prior to the opening of the state highway.
6. If this permit is for a parade, an occasional break shall be made in the procession at highway intersections so traffic may pass through.

Your cooperation in minimizing confusion and delay to through-traffic is earnestly solicited.

A RESOLUTION

AUTHORIZING the Mayor and City Clerk to apply for a State Highway Permit from the Illinois Department of Transportation and to execute the necessary forms in conjunction with the Unity Pride Parade, sponsored by QC Pride Inc, scheduled for Saturday, June 18, 2022.

WHEREAS, QC Pride Inc, is sponsoring this annual parade, scheduled for Saturday, June 18, 2022, in the City of Moline, which constitutes a public purpose; and

WHEREAS, this event will require temporary closure of all lanes of River Drive from 12<sup>th</sup> Street to 17<sup>th</sup> Street and from River Drive to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and all lanes of Fifth Avenue from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street and from 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to River Drive; and

WHEREAS, 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue and 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue are State highways (IL 92) in the City of Moline; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code authorizes the Department of Transportation to issue permits to local authorities to temporarily close portions of State highways for such public purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

That permission to temporarily close off all lanes of River Drive from 12<sup>th</sup> Street to 17<sup>th</sup> Street and from River Drive to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue and all lanes of Fifth Avenue from 17<sup>th</sup> Street to 12<sup>th</sup> Street and from 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue to River Drive, as above designated, be requested of the Illinois Department of Transportation (“Department”).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this closure shall occur during the approximate time period between 2:00 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Saturday, June 18, 2022.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that traffic from that closed portion of highway shall be detoured over routes with an all-weather surface that can accept the anticipated traffic, which will be maintained to the satisfaction of the Department and which is conspicuously marked for the benefit of traffic diverted from the State highway. The parking of vehicles shall be prohibited on the detour routes to allow an uninterrupted flow of two-way traffic.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Moline assumes full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of the traffic during the time the detour is in effect.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police or authorized flaggers shall, at the expense of the City of Moline or its licensees, agents or contractors, be positioned at each end of the closed section and at other points (such as intersections) as may be necessary to assist in directing traffic through the detour.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that police officers, flaggers, and officials shall permit emergency vehicles in emergency situations to pass through the closed area as swiftly as is safe for all concerned.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all debris shall be removed from the City of Moline prior to re-opening the State highway.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such signs, flags, barricades, etc. shall be used by the City of Moline as may be approved by the Department. These items shall be provided by the City of Moline or its licensees, agents or contractors.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the closure and detour shall be marked according to the Illinois Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the fullest extent permitted by law, the City of Moline shall be responsible for any and all injuries to person or damages to property and shall indemnify and hold harmless the Illinois Department of Transportation, its officers, employees and agents from any and all claims, lawsuits, actions, costs and fees (including reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses) of every nature or description, arising out of or resulting from or connected with the exercise of authority granted by the Department which is the subject of this resolution. The obligation is binding upon the City of Moline regardless of whether or not such claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the act, omission or negligence of the Department or its officers, employees or agents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Moline shall provide a comprehensive general liability insurance policy or an additional insured endorsement in the minimum amount of \$1,000,000 per person and \$2,000,000 aggregate which names the Illinois Department of Transportation and its officials, employees, and agents as insured and which protects them from all claims arising from the requested road closing. A copy of said policy or endorsement will be provided to the Department before the road is closed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be forwarded to the Illinois Department of Transportation to serve as a formal request for the permission sought in this resolution and to operate as part of the conditions of said permission.


