<u>PARTIES</u>: The LICENSOR is the City of Moline, Illinois, a municipal corporation,

hereinafter called the CITY.

The LICENSEE is Anamaria Rocha, hereinafter called the LICENSEE.

PREMISES: On 5th Avenue and 12th Street; between 4th and 6th Avenue next to 11th

Street, Moline, IL 61265

<u>USE</u>: LICENSEE shall be allowed only to: Use City Owned Property Street Landing

"Mercado on Fifth."

INTEREST LICENSEE acquires only the right to: Use City Owned Property On 5th

Avenue and 12th Street; between 4th Avenue and 6th Avenue next to 11th Street and street closure, 12th Street for "Mercado on Fifth" takes place every Friday from May 27th to September 30th with the exception of August 26th 2022. Pre-Mercado event on May 26th from 5-8 p.m. and a Lucha Libre

event on June 24th which will require the closure of 12th street

The Licensing Agreement is not assignable without prior written approval of the CITY and the LICENSEE shall give the CITY at least twenty-one (21) days notice in writing of the intention to assign. If assignment is made without notice and approval, the CITY, in addition to any remedies for breach hereof, may hold the LICENSEE responsible for all things to be done, fees to be paid and documents to be filed under the terms hereof. No proprietary, ownership, possessory, possessatory, or other rights, except as

specifically given herein, are to be acquired by the LICENSEE.

<u>TERM</u>: The term of this Licensing Agreement is from 3:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m.

(includes set-up and tear down) on May 27. 2022 through September 2022.

Every Friday.

<u>FEE</u>: \$50 fee paid for Special Event application.

CONDITIONS: LICENSEE shall indemnify and hold the CITY harmless from all acts in

connection with use or misuse of the premises, and from any/all accidents on the premises. The LICENSEE shall procure, at its own expense, an Insurance Policy also **naming the CITY as additional insured** to protect the CITY from all damages to person or property on the premises resulting from accidents on the premises and also **naming the STATE OF ILLINOIS**

as an additional insured, if applicable. Said policy or certificate shall be

deposited with the CITY prior to the event and shall be in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00, pursuant to Chapter 6, Section 2104, of the Moline Code of Ordinances.

LICENSEE shall be the primary insured.

LICENSEE shall have the duty and responsibility to maintain the premises in a safe and neat condition, as determined by the CITY.

Upon termination of the Licensing Agreement, LICENSEE shall restore the premises to its condition prior to issuance of Licensing Agreement, or property on the premises shall become the property of the CITY - at the CITY's option.

Any construction on the premises shall be done under the direction of the CITY. The CITY and its authorized agents shall have the right to enter upon the premises for municipal purposes.
