Notice of Disclaimer and Indemnification

The City of Moline, in participating in the Backwater Valve Program does not represent, guarantee or assume any liability whatsoever as to the prevention or reduction of sewage or drainage backup into residential properties of property owners participating in this Program.

For and in consideration of my participation in the City of Moline Backwater Valve Program, as the property owner of the above-referenced property, I do hereby, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, remise, release, indemnify and forever discharge the City of Moline, Illinois, a municipal corporation, its officers, employees, agents and assigns from any and all manner of action or actions, cause and causes of action, suits, debts, dues, sums of money, accounts, reckonings, bonds, bills, specialties, covenants, contracts, controversies, agreements, promises, trespasses, damages, judgments, executions, claims and demands whatsoever, in law or equity, for anything that has occurred or may occur pursuant to the installation or maintenance of a backwater valve on my property. I recognize that the installation of the backwater valve may cause a failure in the sanitary sewer service itself if such service is in poor or deteriorated condition, and that said failure may be due to extra pressure that has not heretofore been placed upon it. I acknowledge that the installation of the backwater valve is for the purpose of preventing or reducing sewer or drainage backup, but that the City does not represent, guarantee or assume any liability whatsoever in the event backup and/or damage occurs. I further understand and agree that any reimbursement made by the City to me pursuant to this Program is not to be considered as an admission on the part of the City or its agents of any liability whatsoever. I hereby also agrees that in order to receive reimbursement for the installation and/or material costs referenced above, I must adhere to the guidelines set forth in this Backwater Valve Program General Policy, including obtaining a plumbing permit prior to installation of the valve, adhering to the City's applicable building and plumbing codes, and providing the Moline Plumbing Inspector access to the property for the purpose of inspecting the completed valve installation.

I now state that the only consideration for my signing this Notice is for my participation in the Backwater Valve Program as stated above; that no other promise or agreement of any kind or nature has been made with me by the City or its agents to cause me to sign this Notice; and that I fully understand the meaning and intent of this instrument.
