LEAD HAZARD REDUCTION GRANT

The City of Moline is the lead entity for the Illinois Quad Cities Healthy Homes Coalition (IQCHHC) which was recently awarded the Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Grant, in the amount of \$2.4 million. Under the IQCHHC Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction Grant, 151 residential units will be made lead safe (during a 42-month period) in the Cities of Moline, East Moline, Rock Island, and Silvis. Additional lead contractors are needed to meet the demand to address lead in the community housing stock.

LEAD PAINT ABATEMENT SUPERVISOR

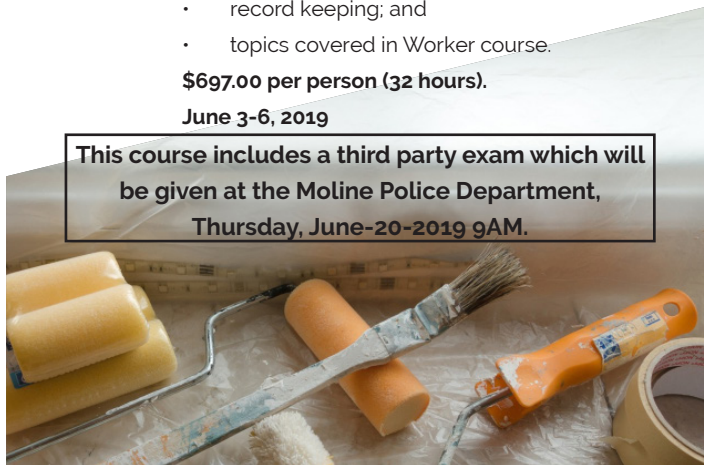
This course focuses on removal and encapsulation of lead-based paint and covers the training guidelines established by HUD for those who supervise or oversee projects where lead-based paint is disturbed. Topics include:

- legal issues;
- supervisory techniques;
- air monitoring;
- record keeping; and
- topics covered in Worker course.

LEAD SAFETY FOR RENOVATION, REPAIR AND PAINTING

This course is in accordance with OSHA 40 CFR 745, the EPA Rannovation, Repair and Painting Rule and HUD Lead Safe Housing Rule. Topics include:

- RRP rule;
- lead safe work practices;
- set up procedures;
- personal protection equipment;
- dust control;
- clean up practices;
- recordkeeping; and
- hands on experiences.
